Lyric Preludes is an introduction to the whole Romantic period -- from Chopin and Schumann to Brahms and Debussy. Like Chopin, Gillock has written 24 preludes featuring all major and minor keys. But his preludes aren't just imitations of other composer's styles, they are valid, original works. An essential book for all pianists. The precision of the tango...the rhythmic excitement of a flamenco guitarist...the clicking of wooden castanets...the whirling of great dancers. Such impressions of

Spain are captured effectively by Catherine Rollin in this fantastic sequel to *Sounds of Spain Book 1*. Seven intermediate solos explore many of the diverse dance and harmonic elements that make up the colorful Spanish music tradition. All are very manageable technically, yet contain dramatic sections that sound difficult and showy. Great crowd-pleasers!

Jazz, Rags & Blues, Book 1 contains original solos for late elementary to early intermediate-level pianists that reflect the various styles of the jazz idiom. An excellent way to introduce your students to this distinctive American contribution to 20th century music. Part of the *Treasury of Sheet Music* selected and edited by FRANCES CLARK. (Music Sales America). The compositions in *Easy Piano Pieces for Children* have all been carefully selected for the beginner pianist. Over 100 selections in this songbook are progressively graded, with editorial markings and suggested fingering, allowing beginner children to learn with specially selected songs that they will enjoy playing. This large songbook includes classic favorites by Mozart, Debussy and Grieg, piano miniatures by Schumann, Arensky and Turk, as well as selections from Bartok's *For Children*, among many others. Each piece is graded with a star to indicate difficulty, while a glossary of music symbols and a keyboard chart

are included to help early students with note and key recognition. (Piano Solo Sheets). This sheet music features an intermediate-level piano solo arrangement of the beloved Beethoven work.

Beginner Piano/Keyboard Instruction "During Visit 1, Clinicians provide survivors with an introduction and overview of the MAAT program and review the eight-session training schedule. Because of its Baroque style, 'Fanfare' points the way to later Bach playing and is perfectly delightful in itself. The short pieces with such story-book titles as 'Cuckoo in the Palace Garden,' 'Tapestry Weavers,' 'The Lute Player,' and 'Lullaby of an Old Nursemaid' can either stand alone or be combined into suites for attractive recital groups. (Willis).

Piano All the Way! is a multi-key course of study written and composed for the beginning piano pupil.
